



LAURENTIA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL EVALUATION PLAN – 2017-2018

The following information pertains to the main evaluations that will concern your child during the school year.

Grade One 2017-2018 School Year	
Main evaluations	
English Language Arts	At the end of each term, students will be evaluated on their reading, writing, speaking and listening skills. The student's knowledge of writing, spelling and reading will be evaluated on a regular basis through different means (tests, workbooks, and written work).
Mathematics	At the end of each term students will be evaluated on their ability to solve problems using mathematical reasoning. The student's knowledge of each math lesson will be evaluated on a regular basis through different means (end of unit tests, quizzes, workbooks and various math activities).
French Second Language	At the end of each term, students will be evaluated on their reading skills through oral reading and different reading tasks. Writing skills will be evaluated through spelling tests, dictations and written productions only in Terms 2 & 3. Oral communication (expression and comprehension) will be evaluated on a daily basis through conversation and oral presentations.

Also note that you will receive the following official communications during the school year:

Official communications	
First written communication	The purpose of this communication is to inform parents about their child's progress, behaviour and attitude towards school and education. There are no marks. This report will be sent home on October 13 th , 2017.
First report card	November 15 th , 2017. This is an official report containing the results of evaluations and observations on effort, attitude and work habits. The report card will be sent by email. Parent/Teacher interviews will take place on November 22 nd , 2017.
Second report card	February 28 nd , 2018. This is an official report containing the results of evaluations and observations on effort, attitude and work habits. Portfolio Night will be held on March 1 st , 2018.
Third report card	First week of July, 2018. This is the final and official report containing the results of evaluations and observations on effort, attitude and work habits as well as final grades, pondered over each of the previous terms.
