



## LAURENTIA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL EVALUATION PLAN - 2017-2018

The following information pertains to the main evaluations that will concern your child during the school year.

<b>Grade Three 2017-2018 School Year Main evaluations</b>	
<b>English Language Arts</b>	Cooperative group participation, book report assessments, reading log assessments, DRA reading and text comprehension assessments, oral presentation (rubric), grammar review tests, reading comprehension evaluations, writing rubrics, Daily 5 observation assessment for oral reading. Journal writing, story-writing assessments, spelling sentence – writing assessments
<b>Mathematics</b>	Mid-unit review tests, end-of-unit review tests, classroom observations, cooperative group participation, timed drill tests.
<b>French Second Language</b>	At the end of each term, students will be evaluated on their reading skills through comprehension tests. Writing skills will be evaluated through spelling tests, dictations and written productions. Oral communication (expression and comprehension) will be evaluated on a daily basis through conversation and oral presentations.

**Work habits, class participation, working to potential, group accountability and participation will be reflected in the comments. Communication will take place via the agenda and interviews, as well as Open House**

<b>Official communications</b>	
<b>First written communication</b>	The purpose of this communication is to inform parents about their child’s progress, behaviour and attitude towards school and education. There are no marks. October 13 <sup>th</sup> , 2017.
<b>First report card</b>	November 15 <sup>th</sup> , 2017. This is an official report containing the results of evaluations and observations on effort, attitude and work habits. Parent/Teacher interviews will take place on November 22 <sup>nd</sup> , 2017.
<b>Second report card</b>	February 28 <sup>th</sup> , 2018. This is an official report containing the results of evaluations and observations on effort, attitude and work habits.  Portfolio Night will be held on March 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2018
<b>Third report card</b>	First week of July 2018. This is the final and official report containing the results of evaluations and observations on effort, attitude and work habits as well as final grades, pondered over each of the previous terms.
