The following information pertains to the main evaluations that will concern your child during the school year.

Grade 4 2017-2018 School Year Main Evaluations	
English Language Arts	Reading responses, narratives, oral presentations and various other pieces of writing will be evaluated through the use of rubrics. The use of novel studies, comprehension and grammar will be evaluated based on tests and assignments. There will be a Learning Evaluation Situation (EXAM) at the end of the year.
Mathematics	Students will be evaluated using unit tests, interim tests, classroom observations and a mandatory end of year Grade 4 exam.
French Second Language	At the end of each term, students will be evaluated on their reading skills through comprehension tests. Writing skills will be evaluated through spelling tests, dictations and written productions. Oral communication (expression and comprehension) will be evaluated on a daily basis through conversation and oral presentations.

First written communication	The purpose of this communication is to inform parents about their child's progress, behaviour and attitude towards school and education. There are no marks. October 13 th , 2017
First report card	November 15 th , 2017. This is an official report containing the results of evaluations and observations on effort, attitude and work habits. Parent/Teacher interviews will take place on November 22 nd , 2017.
Second report card	February 28 th , 2018. This is an official report containing the results of evaluations and observations on effort, attitude and work habits. Portfolio Night will be held on March 1 st , 2018.
Third report card	The first week of July. This is the final and official report containing the results of evaluations and observations on effort, attitude and work habits as well as final grades, pondered over each of the previous terms.
