French Second Language	<p>At the end of each term, students will be evaluated on their reading skills through comprehension tests. Writing skills will be evaluated through spelling tests, dictations and written productions. Oral communication (expression and comprehension) will be evaluated on a daily basis through conversation and oral presentations.</p> <p>At the end of the school year, students will take a compulsory ministerial examination that will count for 20% of the final mark.</p>

Official communications	
First written communication	The purpose of this communication is to inform parents about their child’s progress, behaviour and attitude towards school and education. There are no marks. October 13 th , 2017.
First report card	November 15 th , 2017. This is an official report containing the results of evaluations and observations on effort, attitude and work habits. Parent/Teacher interviews will take place on November 22 nd , 2017.
Second report card	February 28 th , 2018. This is an official report containing the results of evaluations and observations on effort, attitude and work habits. Portfolio Night will be held on March 1 st , 2018, 2017
Third report card	The first week of July. This is the final and official report containing the results of evaluations and observations on effort, attitude and work habits as well as final grades, pondered over each of the previous terms.
