MAY and JUNE at LAURENTIA

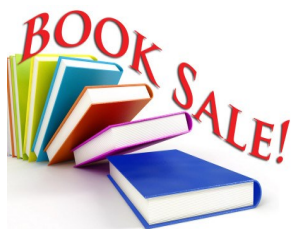
